## 3. Someone to certify your ID

Find "someone of standing" in the community (who has known you for at least one year) then show them the original and the photocopy of your ID. People who qualify include:

- A Justice of the Peace.
- A bank officer with a least two years continuous service.
- An accountant with at least two years continuous service (who's also a member of the Australian Institute of Chartered Accountants, CPA Australia or the National Institute of Accountants).
- A solicitor or barrister, A police officer, An agent in charge of, or a permanent employee of Australia Post (with at least two years of continuous service).

## 4. Certifying the copy

Because you're supplying a photocopy of your ID, it needs to be certified as accurate. Here's what the certifier has to do:

Write these words on the photocopy:

- I hereby certify this document is a true copy of the original document as sighted by me.
- Sign it.
- Give their full name, occupation, professional/employee number or address, and the date the document was certified.
